Caesars Entertainment Earns Perfect Score in Corporate Equality Index for Ninth Consecutive Year

- Caesars Entertainment Earns 100 Percent on Human Rights Campaign Foundation's Fourteenth Annual Scorecard on LGBT Workplace Equality -

LAS VEGAS, Nov. 18, 2015 /PRNewswire/ -- Caesars Entertainment, the world's most diversified casino-entertainment provider, announced today that it has received a score of 100 percent on the 2016 Corporate Equality Index (CEI) for the ninth year in a row. Caesars was the first gaming company to both achieve and maintain a perfect score on the CEI.



The CEI, administered by the Human Rights Campaign Foundation, is a national benchmarking survey and report on corporate policies and practices related to LGBT workplace equality. Caesars Entertainment joins the ranks of 391 major U.S. businesses that also earned top marks this year.

"While 2015 will be remembered as the year 'love won,' we still need legislation that supports the rights of the LGBT community, including the Equality Act, which will protect all Americans from discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity," said Jan Jones Blackhurst, Executive Vice President of Communications, Government Relations & Corporate Responsibility at Caesars. "Caesars is actively leading the change we want to see, which contributes to our deep appreciation of the recognition from the Human Rights Campaign. We will continue to champion diversity and equal rights throughout our organization and beyond our walls."

The 2016 CEI rated 1,024 businesses in the report, which evaluates LGBT-related policies and practices including non-discrimination workplace protections, domestic partner benefits, transgender-inclusive health care benefits, competency programs, and public engagement with the LGBT community. Caesars Entertainment's efforts in satisfying all of the CEI's criteria results in a 100 percent ranking and the designation as a Best Place to Work for LGBT Equality.
